PARADE LINE-UP LOCATION! Line-up will be on Roswell St – line-up WILL NOT be on North Main St/Hwy 9. Parade route remains the same and the Grandstand will remain at City Hall. Parade begins at the corner of Milton Ave and SR9, continuing past Grandstand at City Hall. The parade ends at the American Legion Post 201 on Wills Rd.

- **Directions for vehicle line up**: Traveling on GA 400 take Old Milton Parkway and travel west towards (SR9) Hwy 9; take a left going south on SR 9 (South Main St) until you arrive at Wills Rd. Go right on Wills Rd then right on Old Milton Parkway. Continue about ¼ mile, and a parade marshal will direct you to your parade position. See map attached. All High School units will stage at Milton Center,86 School Dr
- Attach the enclosed position # card to your unit's front left windshield. This assures that you
 are properly announced by the Master of Ceremonies and identifies you to the photographer.
- Parade route begins at corner of Milton Ave and SR9, at Alpharetta City Hall and travels south on SR 9 to
 Old Milton Pkwy. Take a right going west on Old Milton Pkwy. Several units have been notified to de-stage
 and exit at Wills Park. Others proceed and cross over Wills Rd. where Old Milton Pkwy will become Rucker
 Rd. A police officer will direct you into the American Legion Post by taking a right to the dirt driveway.
- All participants are responsible for their own transportation in the parade.


